Minutes

Agenda Memo - A motion authorizing the purchase of new office equipment from Villa Park Office Equipment to replace current equipment in use by the police department using Department of Justice award money in the amount of \$23,018.94. Chief Thomas explained that the department has been remodeling the building which included expanding the sergeant's office to accommodate the (6) six sergeants currently on staff. This purchase is to replace the old furniture that is old and falling apart. The purchase was unanimously approved.

Agenda Memo – A resolution adopting the DuPage County Natural Hazards Mitigation Plan. Chief Thomas explained that this plan comes up for renewal once every 5 years. This allows us to receive federal funds in conjunction with the County in cases of tornadoes, flooding, earthquakes, etc.

Chief's Monthly Report

Chief Thomas reviewed the highlights of his report with the committee. He highlighted the new Frontline system implemented recently by the department. This system was given to our department at no cost to the City of Darien. ISSUE STATEMENT

A resolution authorizing the purchase of new video surveillance systems for the Police and Municipal Services departments from Current Technologies in the amount of \$101,754.

BACKGROUND/HISTORY

The City constructed the police department approximately 23 years ago and some of the video surveillance system that was installed at that time is still in use today. The original system's design used CCTV (closed-circuit television) cameras. The City restructured the system over the years; however, it has always continued to use a CCTV platform that has become dated technology. It would be more cost effective long term to convert the system to a POE (Power over Ethernet) high definition IP camera system.

High definition video surveillance systems offer video clarity that a CCTV system cannot match. The new systems run faster, provide vastly improved video quality and can quickly transfer video over our existing computer network as they use NVR's (network video records) along with IP cameras. These cameras can process video internally before sending it over the network, thereby reducing network bandwidth load.

The current system is not meeting the needs of the police department as the video recorded is of a poor quality and the process to copy video for evidence/court purposes is slow. There are a number of areas in the building; including areas of the jail area that currently are not, video recorded which could be problematic in the event of a lawsuit. We are adding additional cameras to address this issue. The new system would also include additional outdoor cameras to address the need for full 360° property coverage.

The State of Illinois has also imposed new laws requiring mandatory video and audio recording of subjects interviewed in regards to major crimes as well as some lesser offenses. There is currently one recorded interview room in both the upper and lower levels of the building. We expect the list of mandated recordings to grow even larger, in anticipation of this change; two (2) more interview rooms will be equipped with video/audio recording capabilities.

The public works department also uses a CCTV video surveillance system. Their system has some cameras that are no longer operable and upgrading the system would provide high definition video of the entire property, we are also adding an additional camera to increase outside building coverage to a full 360°. The police department currently has the ability to view the cameras at the public works building. If public works does not upgrade their system, they will become a stand-alone system that the police department could not monitor.

The Darien Police Department is a proud participant in the United States Department of Justice Equitable Sharing Fund for State and Local Law Enforcement Agencies. For the last two years, the Darien Police Department has participated in federal task forces whose goal is to stem the flow of illegal narcotics into the Chicago metropolitan area, which is one of the major hubs for illegal narcotics coming into the United States. It is the goal of this program to not only cut off the flow of illegal narcotics into the area, but to take away and use the tools, proceeds and property derived from any criminal activity against the offenders. These seized tools, proceeds and property are ultimately a deterrent to criminal activity and an enhancement to law enforcement. Under the *Guidelines of the Equitable Sharing Program*, the funds received cannot be used to replace or supplant the police department's regularly budgeted monies but augment the police budget. These seized monies may only be used by the police department in order to

augment the police budget. This purchase meets the *Guidelines of the Equitable Sharing Program* and will provide an important tool for the police department that otherwise would not be available without participation in the Equitable Sharing Program. The cash balance of this fund is \$290,131.59 as of 10-31-18. The Municipal Services Department budget includes \$26,000 for this project. (\$13,000 in streets account 01-30-4223, and \$13,000 in water account 02-50-4223)

1. **AGREEMENT.** This Agreement shall become effective upon the execution by Customer and acceptance and execution of this Agreement by a duly authorized representative of Reliable Fire Equipment Company dba Reliable Fire & Security (hereafter called "Company"), at Company's home office in Alsip, Illinois. This Agreement is comprised of these Terms and Conditions, and the Company's proposal set forth on the reverse (hereafter called "Proposal") and other documents referred to in the Proposal, all of which are incorporated by reference. Collectively these terms and conditions and the Proposal are referred to as the Agreement.
2. **SALE OF SYSTEM AND RELATED EQUIPMENT.** Company shall sell to Customer and the Customer shall purchase from the Company the system and related equipment ("System") identified in the Proposal.
3. **INSTALLATION.** Company shall install or cause to be installed the System at Customer's location identified in the Proposal. Company shall install or cause to be installed the System in a workmanlike manner and in compliance with applicable law. Installation shall commence on or about the date identified in the Proposal and shall continue until completed. The completion date is an estimate only and customer acknowledges that technical problems may arise with respect to the installation of the System and, accordingly, Company shall not be held responsible for any delays caused by unforeseen difficulties or unexpected conditions. If during the installation, Company encounters unforeseen difficulties or discovers unexpected conditions (including, without limitation unexpected hazardous materials, waste or substance), Company shall be permitted to stop work immediately. Company shall contact the Customer so the Customer can instruct the Company as to what steps should be taken in connection with unforeseen difficulties or unexpected conditions. Company shall be paid for any additional work performed as a result of such unforeseen difficulties or unexpected conditions. Customer may order additions, deletions, revisions or other changes in the work requested by Customer in the absence of an appropriate writing signed and approved by the Customer and Company.
4. **PRICE AND PAYMENT.** Customer agrees to pay Company the price for the System set forth on the Proposal. The price includes the related equipment and/or installation. The price is based upon the location and environment specifications which Customer provided to Company and upon the assumption that the site specifications are accurate and that, except as set forth in the Proposal, no alteration or modification of the location is required. If alteration, modification or rebuilding of the location is required, the price shall be increased to include the cost of additional labor. All charges shall be paid as set forth in the Proposal. All billed amounts more than thirty (30) days past the date of invoice shall incur interest at the rate of fifteen (15%) percent per annum or the maximum rate permitted by applicable law, whichever is less. If Company retains a collection agency, legal counsel or incurs any out-of-pocket expenses to collect overdue payments, all such collection costs shall be paid by Customer. Company shall not be obligated to extend credit or financing terms to Customer. Customer acknowledges that, other than Company's completion of installation of the System, payment to Company is not contingent on any occurrence, matter or event, including, without limitation, Customer's receipt of payment from any third party such as an owner or insurance company.
5. **APPROVAL AND PERMITS.** Customer shall be responsible for obtaining, at Customer's expense, all necessary approvals, permits and documents required by applicable law.
6. **ACCESS TO SITE.** Customer agrees that Company shall have complete use of and unrestricted access to the installation site at all times during normal working hours for purposes of installation, inspection, testing and supervision. Customer represents and warrants that the site will be free of any gas including, without limitation, flammable, explosive or poisonous gases. Customer shall provide all necessary security, elevator use, heat, lighting and electrical service for Company to complete the installation. Customer shall deliver to Company all records, sketches, drawings, photographs, prototypes, data or models and any and all other documentation and information in possession of Customer relating, directly or indirectly, to Company's performance of the installation of the System at the site. Company shall be entitled to rely upon instructions or requests given by the Customer, its employees, agents or other representatives to Company and such instructions or requests shall be binding upon the Customer. The Customer shall cooperate fully with the Company in connection with Company's performance of the installation and take any and all action reasonable requested by Company.
7. **TAXES.** The price does not include any applicable taxes and Customer shall pay all federal, state and local sales, use, property, excise or other taxes imposed on or with respect to the installation of the System. **If Customer is tax exempt, then prior to executing this Agreement, Customer will provide Company with a valid and correct tax exemption certificate.** Failure to provide a tax exemption certificate in a timely fashion may result in Customer losing the advantages of tax exemption with regard to this sale.
8. **GRANT OF SECURITY INTEREST.** Customer, on behalf of the owner and Customer, grants to Company a security interest in the System to secure payment of the purchase price and grants to Company an irrevocable power of attorney to execute and file UCC-1 Financing Statements on behalf of Customer for the benefit of company, as secured creditor, to protect the security interest. Upon payment in full of the purchase price, and all associated costs and charges required under this Agreement, title to the system shall pass to Customer. Company shall have all of the rights of a secured creditor under the Uniform Commercial Code in Illinois including the right to enter Customer's premises and to disable or remove the System and related equipment, or both.
9. **TERMINATION.** Company shall have the right to terminate this Agreement immediately or withhold performance of services pursuant to this Agreement in the event: Customer is delinquent in payment of any sums due under that Agreement; Customer files a petition in bankruptcy; Customer has a bankruptcy petition filed against it; or Customer is unable to pay its debts as they mature, or makes an assignment for the benefit of its creditors. In the event this Agreement is terminated for any reason, the balance of the purchase price and all associated costs and charges required to be paid by Customer under this Agreement including, without limitation, an amount equal to the profit Company would have received had the work been completed, shall be immediately due and payable.
10. **LOCATION ENVIRONMENT.** Customer will prepare and maintain the location in conformance with Company's site specifications as defined in the appropriate site preparation document. Customer shall furnish Company with surveys describing the physical characteristics, legal limitations and utility locations for the alto.
11. **FORCE MAJEURE.** Company will be excused from any delay or failure to perform under this Agreement due, in whole or in part, directly or indirectly, to labor difficulties, fire, casualty or accidents, acts of God, civil disorder, transportation difficulties, shortage of fuel, labor or materials, governmental acts or restrictions, or any other cause beyond Company's reasonable control.
12. **BREACH BY COMPANY.** Customer expressly agrees that no action at law or in equity shall be maintained by Customer against Company for Company's alleged breach of this Agreement or violation of any federal or state law now in effect or hereafter enacted with respect to any obligation or

duty incurred under this Agreement by Company, unless: (i) Customer notifies Company in writing at the address specified in this Agreement within ten (10) days from date of such alleged breach or violation, and provided Company does not remedy or correct the breach or violation within sixty (60) days from the receipt of the notice; and (ii) such action at law or in equity is commenced by Customer within one (1) year from the finished date of the installation of the System.

13. LIMITATION OF LIABILITY.

- a. Company's obligation under this Agreement is to install the System in a workmanlike manner in compliance with applicable law and regulations.
- b. Company shall have no liability for loss of anticipated profits, incidental, consequential or special damages and shall not be liable, for any reason, whether under this Agreement or otherwise, for any loss, cost, expense or damage suffered by customer or any other person, including, without limitation, cost, expense, loss or damage:
 - i. Resulting directly or indirectly, from the use or loss of use of the System;
 - ii. Such as personal injury and property damage;
 - iii. Such as any claim or demand against Customer by any third party.
- c. If Company has any liability under this Agreement, it shall be to repair or replace a defective item, at Company's discretion and in the event Company is unable or unwilling to repair or replace, Customer agrees that Company's liability shall not exceed, under any circumstances, the amounts paid to Company by customer under this Agreement.

14. NO WARRANTIES. EXCEPT AS EXPRESSLY STATED IN THE PROPOSAL, COMPANY MAKES NO WARRANTY, EXPRESS OR IMPLIED, REGARDING THE SYSTEM. CUSTOMER WAIVES ANY AND ALL WARRANTIES, EXPRESS OR IMPLIED, NOT EXPRESSLY CONTAINED IN THIS AGREEMENT INCLUDING, WITHOUT LIMITATION, THE WARRANTIES OF MERCHANTABILITY AND FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR USE, AND COMPANY EXPRESSLY WAIVES ALL SUCH IMPLIED WARRANTIES.

15. INDEMNIFICATION. Customer indemnifies Company, holds Company harmless, and agrees to defend Company from and against any and all lawsuits, proceedings (including, without limitation, civil, criminal, administrative and investigative proceedings, whether threatened, pending or completed), claims demands, losses, damages (including, without limitation, indirect, direct, special and consequential damages and insurance deductibles), actions, liabilities (including, without limitation, strict liability and joint and several liability) costs and expenses (including, without limitation, fines, penalties and the reasonable costs of arbitration, costs of appeal, and the reasonable attorneys' fees) (collectively referred to as "Damages" arising out of or relating to, directly or indirectly: a breach of the Agreement by Customer; or the action or inaction of Company in the installation of the System; provided that this provision shall not apply to Damages arising out of or relating to the gross negligence or willful misconduct of Company, which is deemed by a court of competent jurisdiction to have materially and directly contributed to the Damages suffered by the Company; provided further that this provision shall only apply to the extent the Company's insurance coverage does not cover the Damages. As used in this paragraph, the term "Company" shall include Company's employees, agents, representatives, shareholders, officers, directors and subcontractors; at any level, and the subcontractors' representatives, agents, employees, shareholders, officers and directors. This provision shall survive completion of the work and the termination of the Agreement, for any reason.

16. INSURANCE. Customer represents and warrants to Company that it has adequate liability insurance coverage to cover the work to be performed under the Agreement and shall provide Company with evidence of such insurance upon request of Company.

17. SUBROGATION. Each party waives rights of subrogation against the other party to the extent of their respective first party insurance coverages, for any and all losses suffered by either party, whether or not caused by the negligence of the Customer or Company or those for whom they are responsible; provided that this release shall be in force and effect only with respect to loss or damage occurring during the time each parties' insurance policies contain a clause to the effect that this release shall not affect said policies or the right of the insured to recover. Each party agrees that its first party insurance policies will contain a clause so long as the same is obtainable without extra costs, or if extra cost is chargeable, so long as the other party pays such extra cost.

18. MISCELLANEOUS.

- a. This Agreement, as defined in paragraph 1, constitutes the entire agreement between the parties and supersedes any previous agreement, understanding or order between the parties. Should the terms and conditions of any purchase order of Customer issued in connection with this Agreement conflict with the terms contained in this Agreement or add any new terms to this Agreement, such new terms or different terms shall be of no force or effect. The terms of this Agreement shall prevail over any terms in Customer's purchase order and different or new terms shall only be binding on Company if expressly accepted in writing by Company. No modification or waiver of the terms of this Agreement shall be binding unless made in writing and signed by both parties.
- b. This Agreement is made and entered into in the State of Illinois and shall be in all respects governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the United States and the State of Illinois as if entirely performed in Illinois and without regard to any conflict of law rules and without regard to any rules of construction or interpretation relating to which party drafted this Agreement. - c. Customer consents to the exclusive jurisdiction and venue of the Cook County Court of Illinois with respect to the enforcement of this Agreement, the collection of any amounts due under this Agreement or any disputes arising under this Agreement. Customer agrees that effective service of process may be made upon Customer by U.S. Mail under the notice provision contained in subparagraph D of this paragraph 18.
- d. All notices or other communications permitted or required to be given in writing under this Agreement shall be sent by certified mail, return receipt requested and directed to the address of Company or Customer shown below. Notice will be deemed to have been given upon the mailing of the notice.
- e. This Agreement is not cancelable by Customer for any reason whatsoever.

19. REMEDIES CUMULATIVE. The remedies provided in this Agreement in favor of Company upon default of Customer shall not be deemed to be exclusive, but shall be cumulative and in addition to all other remedies in Company's favor existing at law or in equity. Company may exercise all remedies, whether or not expressed successively or concurrently, and any such action shall not operate to release Customer until the full amount of all sums due and to become due under this Agreement have been paid.

20. NO ASSIGNMENT. This Agreement may not be assigned by Customer directly or indirectly (including, without limitation, by merger or sale of stock) without the prior written consent of Company, which consent may be withheld by Company, in its sole discretion, for any reason or no reason.

21. **SEVERABILITY.** If any provision of this Agreement is determined by a court of competent jurisdiction to be unenforceable or invalid such provision shall be modified to the extent necessary to eliminate such invalidity or unenforceability, and any remaining unenforceability or invalidity shall have no effect on any of the other terms of the Agreement, which shall remain in full force and effect in accordance with its terms.
22. **COMMERCIAL TRANSACTION.** Customer acknowledges, agrees, represents and warrants that the transactions contemplated by this Agreement are commercial transactions and not for personal, household or family purposes.
23. **COUNTERPARTS.** This Agreement may be executed in counterparts, each of which shall be an original but all of which taken together shall constitute one Agreement.
24. **HEADINGS.** Section headings shall have no effect on the meaning of this Agreement, and are included only for convenience of reference. **TOOLS.** Any special equipment, tools, dies, fixtures, or jigs produced or acquired by Company for the manufacture or installation of articles under this Agreement shall remain the property of Company.
25. **USE OF DESIGNS AND DATA.** Any knowledge or information, including drawings and data, which Company shall have disclosed or may hereafter be Company's confidential and proprietary information and Customer shall take any and all steps as are reasonable to protect the confidentiality of such information. Company does not grant to Customer any reproduction rights or any rights to use such information.
26. **ELECTRIC POWER CONNECTION.** When electric is required for System operation, Customer will provide a separately fused (120 Vac, 60 Hz, 20 Amp) primary power with ground within 6 feet of control panel location. To assure uninterrupted service, this power should come from the main electric distribution center.
27. **SERVICES NOT INCLUDED.**
- All Plan Review and Permit Fees are not included unless otherwise noted.
 - When a labor price is submitted, it is based on all work being performed during a five (5) day forty (40) hour work week. If overtime or premium time is performed, an additional charge will be made to the Customer. Normal work weeks are 7:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, except Company holidays.
 - Unless otherwise specifically provided in the Proposal, Customer agrees to do all necessary patching of masonry work; painting, carpentry work and the like.
 - Customer shall also provide a wiring, conduit and labor to connect the provided pressure switches to an equipment to be turned on or off such as alarms, motors, conveyors, fans or cooking equipment.
 - Customer shall also provide necessary hardware and linkage to permit automatic closing of doors, windows, duct dampers, etc, upon actuation of any provided pressure release trip device. Unless specifically indicated in the Proposal, services do not include costs for any discharge or concentration tests required by approval authorities.

The subcontractor is the Company, and the contractor is the Customer, and the amount claimed will be the balance due under this Agreement, and any amendments or change orders as of the date of filing a mechanics' lien claim. Customer agrees to promptly notify the owner of the premises on which work is to be performed of this Mechanics' Lien Notice.
29. **AGREEMENT MODIFICATION.** No terms or conditions, other than those stated herein, and no agreement or understanding in any way of modifying the terms and conditions herein stated, shall be binding upon Company or Customer unless made in writing and signed by Company and Customer.
30. **PREVAILING WAGE** *Company's work/services performed shall be based on its understanding through the actions, statements and/or omissions of Customer that this project [identify] and the work performed relating thereto is not subject to prevailing wage requirements (federal, state or local). If Company's understanding is incorrect, Customer agrees and acknowledges that it shall immediately notify Company in writing within forty-eight (48) hours from receiving this notice so that Company may submit a revised proposal and/or invoice reflecting the additional costs associated with applicable prevailing wage laws. If at any time it is determined that this project is or was subject to prevailing wage requirements under federal, state or local law, then Customer agrees and acknowledges that it shall reimburse and make whole Company for any back wages, penalties and/or interest owed to its employees or any other third party, including any appropriate governmental agency. Customer also agrees that prices, costs and/or applicable fees will also be increased prospectively as required by the increase in wage payments to Company's employees. Customer understands and acknowledges that it shall notify Company of any prevailing wage requirements or obligations under applicable laws relating to the work or services performed by Company. ISSUE STATEMENT

A resolution to adopt the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) regarding the Peer Jury Program between the Village of Downers Grove and the City of Darien.

BACKGROUND/HISTORY

The Peer Jury Program began in 2000 and was active in DuPage County with the township administering the program. A few years ago, the township no longer funded/managed the program. Downers Grove Police Department felt the program had merit and reinstated it and will administer the program. In addition to Darien and Downers Grove, six (6) other agencies will participate in the program (Oak Brook, Burr Ridge, Clarendon Hills, Hinsdale, Willow Brook, and Westmont). In the past, Darien used the program approximately 12 times a year until we discontinued it in 2017. Staff estimates the annual cost to Darien will be \$1,200.

The program operates much in the same way it had in the past. It is for individuals 18 and under who are first time offenders charged with a minor violation. The charged individual has to agree to peer jury and so does the minor's parents / legal guardian. There is a fee of \$100 paid by the minor (parents) to enter into the program. The program which is designed to have a group (trained) of the minors peers (same age group) hear the allegations and make a determination on how to address the matter. Outcomes the jury could impose include writing a letter of apology, community service work, etc. The minor would be given a second Peer Jury date where s/he would return to show that s/he completed the restorative justice requirements. The minor would not have a record.

Currently, at Darien Police Department, there is either a station adjustment means of handling a minor or referring the minor to Juvenile Court Services. There is no viable middle area where the minor can have some type of meaningful deferral program.

The attached resolution describes in Section 3 the responsibilities of Downers Grove in administering the program and Section 4 describes the responsibilities of the City of Darien. Section 5 details the fee structure. This is a six-month pilot program, which begins January 1, 2019 (See Section 2).

Attorney John Murphey has reviewed the MOU and advised it is appropriate if the City chooses to enter the agreement.

STAFF/COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION

**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING REGARDING
THE PEER JURY PROGRAM BETWEEN
THE VILLAGE OF DOWNERS GROVE AND THE CITY OF DARIEN**

THIS MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (the "Agreement") is made this _____ day of _____, 2018, by and among the Village of Downers Grove, an Illinois municipal corporation (hereinafter referred to as "Downers Grove"), and the City of Darien, an Illinois municipal corporation (hereinafter referred to as "Darien"). Downers Grove and Darien are herein jointly referred to as the "Parties".

W I T N E S S E T H:

WHEREAS, Downers Grove and Darien are units of local government; and

WHEREAS, the Parties currently provide police services for their respective municipalities; and

WHEREAS, the Parties currently provide for restorative justice programs within their respective police departments; and

WHEREAS, the Parties have determined that there is a need for a peer jury program to enhance the restorative justice programs; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Parties to enter into this Agreement and for Downers Grove to provide a peer jury program to Darien for its police department.

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to statutory authority, it is agreed by and among the Parties hereto as follows:

Section 1. **Recitals Incorporated.** The foregoing recitals shall be and are hereby adopted as findings of fact as if said recitals were fully set forth within this Section 1.

Section 2. **Effective Date.** This Agreement shall become effective January 1, 2019, and shall remain in effect through June 30, 2019, unless terminated sooner in accordance with the provisions of this Agreement.

Section 3. **Services.** Downers Grove, located at 801 Burlington Avenue, Downers Grove, IL shall provide a fully operational peer jury program that will be accessible to Darien for the adjudication of juvenile cases. Specifically, Downers Grove shall provide the following services:

- a. Select, maintain and train a jury pool consisting of area students;
- b. Provide a jury at each hearing;
- c. Assemble and distribute case information to the jury at each hearing;
- d. Manage and maintain all case files;
- e. Schedule all hearings (both initial and return) at minimum once monthly;
- f. Administer and preside over all hearings;

- g. Provide security and bailiff services at all hearings;
- h. Maintain relationships with community service organizations to facilitate community service assignments;

Section 4. **Participating Municipality Responsibilities.** In order to participate in the peer jury program, Darien shall be responsible for:

- a. Determining which cases to forward to the peer jury program;
- b. Communicating with the offenders regarding case status;
- c. Contacting Downers Grove to schedule a hearing;
- d. Preparing and submitting to Downers Grove case summaries prior to the hearing date;
- e. Collecting and remitting to Downers Grove the \$100 case fee prior to the scheduling of a hearing or submitting a deposit with the Village of Downers Grove to cover the cost of the case fee.

Section 5. **Fees.** Downers Grove will track all costs associated with the operating the peer jury program. Net costs of the peer jury program (total cost minus the case fee revenue) will be shared by all participating municipalities on a cost per case basis. Each participating municipality will be responsible for paying its pro rata share of the peer jury program cost based upon the number of cases submitted to the peer jury program. Downers Grove will invoice each participating municipality at the end of the term of this Agreement for its pro rata share of the peer jury program. Payment in full shall be due thirty (30) days after invoicing.

Section 6. **Termination.** Either party may terminate this Agreement by providing at least thirty (30) days written notice to the other Party.

Section 7. **Notices.** Written notices required pursuant to this Agreement and all other correspondence between the parties shall be directed to the following and shall be deemed received when hand-delivered or three (3) days after being sent by certified mail, return receipt requested:

Section 8. **Entire Agreement.** The Agreement contains the entire agreement of the parties relating to the subject matter hereof, and except as provided herein, may not be modified or amended except by written agreement of the Parties.

Section 9. **Governing Law and Venue.** This Agreement shall be governed by the laws of the State of Illinois, and venue shall be in the County of DuPage.

Section 10. **Severability.** If any part of this Agreement shall be held invalid for any reason, the remainder of this agreement shall remain valid to the maximum extent possible.
