Listed below are the agenda topics and overview for the goal setting session scheduled for Wednesday, November 19th. Please note, an * indicates there is back up for that item.

1. Environmental Committee*

At the October 20, 2025, City Council meeting, the Council postponed a vote to disband the Environmental Committee (EC). The consensus of the Council was to include the discussion at the November goal-setting meeting to allow for additional time for discussion. Since 2023, the EC held one meeting with an additional meeting held on November 6, 2025. During the period of 2017 through 2022, the EC held fourteen meetings, with items being mostly informational and repeated annually. The challenge with discretionary committees is to maintain an active role after their initial priority, such as solid waste. At the EC meeting on June 20, 2001, the committee began to review its role and functions. (Minutes attached) After their review in 2001, it is evident that they have struggled for topics and many meetings were cancelled for lack of a quorum or agenda items. The city does not require a formal committee in order to be proactive on environmental issues. Currently, many environmental efforts require expertise and training in a variety of topics related to the environment. City elected officials and staff have taken on the task of meeting environmental concerns and accomplishing numerous goals.

2. Review of the Darien Business Alliance (DBA) activities and future focus*

This is the first year of the city's creation of the Darien Business Alliance. The staff will discuss the DBA business activities to date and a recommended future focus.

3. Review of our marquee sign policy*

The use of the city marquee sign by local businesses has been minimal. The city uses it daily and we do promote many of the local organizations. Staff requesting the city council to consider additional ways for local businesses to use the sign without charge.

4. Resident communications survey review*

Attached is the resident communication survey that the city publicized on Direct Connect. The city council will have a chance to review and discuss the results.

5. Revenue to fund police pension fund

For the last several years, the police pension contribution by the city has exceeded the annual property tax levy. The difference has been paid for with other general fund revenue. The city has not raised the property tax levy since 2009. The council can provide input if the tax property tax revenue should be increased to meet the total annual pension amount, without using other general revenue funds.

6. Meeting decorum

The city's council meetings allows the council to conduct important and useful discussion between the elected officials. The council members can provide input if they may have about any concerns with the process for council discussion among themselves and between the council and the public, with the goal of facilitating/maintaining productive and professional discussion.

7. Elected Officials – Survey review*

Each elected official will have a chance to review their survey focusing on topics they listed to discuss but were not on the agenda due to time constraints.

RE: Environmental Committee

At the October 20, 2025, City Council meeting, the Council postponed a vote to disband the Environmental Committee (EC). The consensus of the Council was to include this topic at the November goal-setting meeting to allow for additional time for discussion. Attached, as background, is the staff memo that was included in the 10/20/25 council meeting packet.

The city maintains various committees that provide recommendations to the city. The committees generally have different purposes. First, committees such as the Board of Fire and Police Commissioners and the Planning, Zoning and Economic Development Commission serve to fulfill duties required by state law. Second, discretionary committees such as EC are created by the city council for specific purposes, but not required by state law.

Since 2023, the EC held one meeting with an additional meeting held on November 6, 2025. During the period of 2017 through 2022, the EC held fourteen meetings, with items being mostly informational and repeated annually. The challenge with discretionary committees is to maintain an active role after their initial priority, such as solid waste. At the EC meeting on June 20, 2001, the committee began to review its role and functions. (See attached minutes) After their review in 2001, it is evident that they have struggled for topics and many meetings were cancelled for lack of a quorum or agenda items.

If the EC were disbanded, the group could continue as a volunteer group, (environmental club), such as the garden club and the Arbor Day volunteers. As an environmental club, they can work to eliminate duplication of activities. For example, the garden club already has a committee called the Nature and Environment Committee. If the group continued as a volunteer club they would not be required to follow the Open Meetings Act (OMA) and would have more flexibility including:

- 1. Would not need a quorum to have meetings
- 2. Would not create a public meeting if a majority of a quorum was not required (3 of 7 committee members discussing issues together)
- 3. Would be able to meet when and where they wanted with no notice requirements
- 4. Would be able to determine the size of the club and solicit new members
- 5. Would determine their issues they feel are important to discuss
- 6. Would be able to raise funds to carry out programs of an environmental nature
- 7. Would still be able to work with the city on environmental issues
- 8. Would not be required to take minutes

Several communities such as Elmhurst and Naperville have volunteer resident groups,

independent from the city, serving in the role as environmental advisors. The Naperville *Environment and Sustainability Task Force* (NEST) https://www.sustainnaperville.org/ is a group of concerned citizens working to enhance environmental sustainability in Naperville. The Cool Cities Coalition (https://elmhurstcoolcities.org/) is the resident organization in Elmhurst that strives to promote sustainable solutions in the Elmhurst community through education, outreach and community action.

The city does not need a formal committee in order to be proactive on environmental issues. A similar example is the city does not need a formal Historical Committee to celebrate the city's history. Currently, many environmental efforts require expertise and training in a variety of topics related to the environment. City staff has taken on the task of meeting environmental concerns and accomplishing numerous goals. Mayor Marchese, City Council and staff have maintained their involvement in environmental issues, and have been active and accomplished the following:

- Through our membership in the Metropolitan Mayor's Caucus, we have attended and participated in the MMC's Environmental sub-committee;
- Through our membership in the MMC, we were part of the first EV Readiness Cohort, which earned us Bronze level status;
- We have applied for grants, through the MMC for the development of EV Super charging stations in Darien, and we were awarded 1.3 million dollars to install charging stations at City Hall and at Public Works. The Brookhaven management was part of this program. While Brookhaven is prepared to open their charging stations, the federal government cut/pulled the 1.3 million which effectively negated our installation of the charging stations;
- As an environmentally conscious community, the City sought to enhance the appearance of our streetscapes, by landscaping our medians, and installing irrigation systems;
- We explored the use of an environmentally safe/biodegradable liquid that whose use we adopted prior to a snow/ice event;
- We explored the need to modify our ordinances detailing the requirements that provide residents with information on the installation of solar panels; this work resulted in our being designated a "Sol Smart" community;
- We have qualified as a "Greenest Region" awarded city;
- Through a grant we obtained from the Morton Arboretum, We are the recipients of 100 donated trees, that per the grant will be planted in parkways where there is poor canopy cover;
- Through a grant program with the State of Illinois, we will have the opportunity to purchase at more than half the cost of a new nine-ton dump truck that is EV equipped. As part of this program, we will also see the installation of a Level three super charger installed at our Public Works facility;
- We are exploring the possibility of being part of the BESS Program (Battery Energy Storage System). BESS units are large rechargeable batteries and associated hardware that store electricity for later use. This system would be installed on a separate property, and the City would receive revenue from the project;

- We have been and continue to be part of the Monarch Butterfly Program, and we continue to urge the development of Milkweed plantings for Monarch Butterflies and pollinators;
- We scheduled two electronics recycling program that included flat screen televisions, computers and assorted electronic equipment;
- Our adoption of LRS as our waste hauler included the use of a tote program that allowed for additional recycling material including composting. In addition, we worked with LRS to conduct an electronic recycling program.
- Revised city zoning codes to prohibit certain chemical storage/use
- Amended the zoning code to prohibit businesses that have Tier II reportable chemicals on their premises
- Recipient of a \$53,000 Illinois Community Canopy Tree Inventory and Management Plan Grant from the Inflation Reduction Act (IRA)

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

The minutes of the 3/21/01 regular meeting were read and approved. A motion to approve the minutes was made by Myra Slifka and seconded by Kathleen Minardi.

COMMUNICATIONS RECEIVED

A letter from the Darien Park District dated 5/28/01 was received thanking the Environmental Committee for their time and efforts on the 2nd Annual Darien Arbor Day Celebration at Ridgewood Park. The Committee also received a framed picture of the group of children and Home Depot volunteers that participated in the park activities on April 26, 2001.

PUBLIC COMMENT

There was no public comment.

CHAIRMAN / LIAISON REPORT

Chairman Avci explained that without committee projects (new or ongoing) the Committee has nothing to really meet about. New ideas or projects for the Committee are not coming from the City Council, so the Committee must create our own. Projects for the Committee like the Arbor Day event are very good for the Committee to work on. Mr. Avci would like the see the Committee create articles for the quarterly Darien Data Newsletter and the City's cable channel. The next newsletter will be Sept. 2001. Gina added that she has been putting Environmental Committee bulletins/briefs on the cable channel for some time now but will also help look for environmental news and information from various sources.

Mrs. Minardi suggested an "Adopt-A-Sign, Park or Street Program be strongly considered using junior high and high school aged students to participate for a class or special assignment, for local clubs, groups or community service projects. She also mentioned the Tree City USA designation for Darien and asked what Darien has done about joining this tree supportive organization. Gina explained that the previous Public Works Director did speak about this to the City Council both at a Goal Setting Session and a Budget meeting. At that time, the City was in the process of beginning to operate a Forestry division of Public Works. Two employees were selected and committed for Arborist training. The

department did look into the Tree City Program but were discouraged at the cost of computer software and the program parameters to complete tree inventory files and reports. The department will look into it again at a later time.

Eric Gustafson reported that the Comprehensive Plan Committee will be going to the Planning & Development Committee for approval consideration of the new Comprehensive Plan. A bikeway is included. It was suggested that grant money might be requested for the bikeway from State and Federal resources. Gina will look at Illinois EPA grant listings. Mr. Gustafson also suggested that the Environmental Committee participate in the Argonne Labs Open House in September, 2001.

Gina mentioned that another suggestion for Environmental Committee exposure would be the Darien Website at www.darien.il.us. She mentioned that she is the website contact with the City. She works with Claycomb Productions, the website contractor who also does the input for the site based on whatever new information and update maintenance Gina supplies to him. It was suggested that the Environmental page should also have a pull-down box that has an email address to write to the Committee with suggestions, questions or comments.

ISSUE STATEMENT

Approval of an ORDINANCE disbanding the environmental committee

BACKGROUND/HISTORY

The city maintains various committees that provide recommendations to the city. The committees generally have different purposes. First, committees such as the Board of Fire and Police Commissioners and the Planning, Zoning and Economic Development Commission serve to fulfill duties required by state law. Second, discretionary committees such as COY and the holiday decorating committees are created by the city council for specific purposes, but not required by state law.

The city currently has a discretionary environmental committee. Under a different name, this committee began in 1987 with an ordinance designating the committee in 2000. The committee had an initial focus on recycling, which was a new topic for Illinois communities in the late 1980s. During this period, municipalities spent significant time in dealing with solid waste issues. In addition to solid waste, the committee discussed items such as litter, inoperable vehicles, selecting a city flower and many general informational items. Many of the issues they discussed were informational only and are being handled by other groups such as city committees and DuPage County. After researching archived meeting minutes, much of the committees' business were less complex than issues we are faced with today that require professional input. Many of the issues the committee discussed are now handled by other volunteer groups such as the garden club and Arbor Day group.

The challenge with discretionary committees is to maintain an active role after their initial priority, such as solid waste. In 2000, the committee began to review its role and functions. After their review in 2000, it is evident that they have struggled for topics and many meetings were cancelled for lack of agenda items. Since 2000, the committee has met once or twice per year with no meetings in 2024. Recently, staff was working to schedule a meeting for the committee and had difficulty in identifying topics and agenda items (Attachment A).

Due to these factors, staff is recommending the city council disband this committee.

STAFF/COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION

The staff and Administrative/Finance Committee recommends the disbanding of the environmental committee.

RE: Darien Business Alliance (DBA) activities and future focus

This is the first full fiscal year of the Darien Business Alliance. The city operates the DBA, which resembles a traditional chamber of commerce. This creation of the DBA allowed the city to have direct oversight of local business engagement such as special business events, communications, and programing. The focus of the DBA so far has been:

- 1. Hosted an introduction to DBA luncheon
- 2. Weekly email newsletter of promotions, events and business related information
- 3. Partner with other chamber events 3-4 times a year
- 4. Assist in preparation of the annual business focused Community Guide Magazine
- 5. Plan/host annual community events providing sponsorship opportunities for business exposure
- 6. Host Shop Local campaign to focus on retail and restaurant holiday promotions

We consider our first business luncheon, held in May, a success. We had a turnout of approximately 70 attendees and provided an excellent speaker discussing AI. We tried for a second business luncheon but cancelled it due to low registration. We have conceded that, while the business luncheons can be valuable, they take significant time to plan and there is just not enough interest in continuing those on a regular basis.

As one tool to support local businesses, staff is considering promoting retail businesses by their individual business center. Some ideas include developing a short video of the center/businesses that we can put on Direct Connect and our web site, encouraging *grand reopening's* that may include certain special deals/events, business ad on marquee sign, etc. If the council supports this approach, staff can put together more details. We will continue to participate in local business/chamber events.

RE: Marquee Sign

The advertising policy for the marquee sign at Plainfield and Cass has now been in place since 2024. Exhibit 1, see attached, shows the information that was posted on the sign in 2025. Also attached is the current sign advertisement policy that was revised on 4-28-25.

The city sponsored and local not for profit (NFP) events are the most advertised. Since the policy revision of 4-28-25, there has been five businesses that advertised for a total revenue to the city of \$1,604. The city staff is pleased with the use of the sign for city and NFP events. However, the use of the sign by local businesses is below expectations.

Currently, the city does not charge for ads if a business sponsors a city event. The staff is recommending expanding the list of no cost ads for businesses that:

- 1. advertise in the Community Guide Magazine
- 2. participate in the city's promotion of retail businesses by their individual business center
- 3. participate in city's special events such as the Shop Local campaign
- 4. participate in programs that benefit local NFP groups

Additionally, we only allow business ads for businesses located in Darien, regardless if they pay dues to the DBA. The council should confirm that we will continue to allow ads for Darien businesses only.

DIGITAL MARQUEE SIGN POLICY

Section 1 – Purpose

This policy establishes the City of Darien's guidelines for the use of the Marquee Sign. This policy applies to all employees and officers for the City, and applicants requesting to post a message to the Marquee Sign.

Section 2 – Objective of the Marquee Sign

The goal of the Marquee Sign is to convey information about Darien programs, events, services, and initiatives, provide emergency alerts and other important City information, and to allow local businesses to advertise.

Section 3 – Guiding Principles

All Marquee Signs are subject to the following rules and guidelines:

- 1. All Marquee Signs will be maintained and monitored by authorized users during normal business hours. During an emergency event, designated personnel may post outside of normal business hours to keep the public informed.
- 2. The Marquee Sign will not be used to:
 - a. Directly or indirectly endorse any person or organization that is not directly associated with the City or other Darien public agency.
 - b. Endorse or promote a political campaign, candidate, or ballot measure.
- 3. Messages posted to the Marquee Sign must comply with applicable federal, state, county, and City laws, ordinances, regulations, and policies. This includes adherence to established laws and policies regarding copyright or plagiarism, records retention, the Freedom of Information Act, privacy and information security policies and protocols established by the City or imposed by existing laws.
- 4. Reservation dates will be issued on a first-come, first-served basis. The City retains the right to approve or deny any request. In the event that the advertisement period is disrupted due to technical difficulties, the City will ensure a full 30-day period of advertisement when the sign is operational. No refunds will be given.
- 5. Content that is graphic, obscene, explicit, abusive, threatening, harmful, inflammatory, intended to defame anyone or any organization, compromise the safety or security of the public or public facilities, suggests or encourages illegal activity, or is misleading or fraudulent in nature will not be permitted.
- 6. Content that promotes, fosters, or perpetuates discrimination on the basis of race, religion, color, age, gender, marital status, national origin, physical or mental disability, gender identity, or sexual orientation, will not be permitted.

Section 4 – Submission Policy

1. Members of the public that wish to post to the Marquee Sign must submit the Digital Marquee Sign Request Form, and meet the following requirements:



- a. Requests for use of the Marquee Sign must be submitted at least one week in advance to the City by completing the attached form, which can be obtained on the City's website www.darien.il.us or at City Hall.
- b. Each business or organization is allowed a maximum of two (2) advertisements per 30-day advertising period.
- c. Message run time is limited to no more than 30 days per event or advertising reservation, unless otherwise authorized by City Staff.
- d. The City reserves the right to limit the number of messages displayed at any one time to keep the sign board relevant, at its sole discretion.
- e. Messages should be concise and should contain basic information about the event or advertisement. The City reserves the right to edit the requested message as they see fit.
- 2. Requests for use of the Marquee Sign for the promotion of Community Events must meet the following additional requirements:
 - a. The requestor must represent a Darien not-for-profit organization that is sponsoring an event, which is open to the Darien community and not for commercial purposes.
 - b. Reservation requests must be submitted with the appropriate application form. Documentation evidencing the organization's non-profit status will be required.
 - c. Events must meet one or more of the following criteria to be eligible:
 - i. City event or activity
 - ii. City sponsored or funded
 - iii. Local governments within the City of Darien's corporate limits or serving Darien's residents
 - iv. Not-for-profit community events open to the public and not exclusionary in nature
 - v. Darien new business grand opening events
 - d. *Revised 4/8/25* City of Darien businesses sponsoring a City event will be permitted to advertise for a full 30-day period at no charge except any required set up fees.
- 3. Requests for paid advertisements to be displayed on the Marquee Sign must meet the following additional requirements:
 - a. Reservation requests must be submitted with the appropriate application form. Documentation evidencing a business license registered to Darien will be required.
 - b. Each advertisement period will cost \$550. *Revised 4/8/25* Each advertisement period will cost \$200 per a promotional rate set by the Darien City Council. The City Administrator reserves the right to adjust advertisement pricing as he may see fit. If the requested advertisement should last less than the 30-day advertising period (i.e., a limited time promotional deal, specials at a grocery store, etc.), price will be adjusted accordingly.


RE: Results – Darien Communication Survey 2025

Attached please find the results of the 2025 Communications Survey. The survey was open from June 24th thru July 27th. The survey included 15 questions for the residents to complete. The total number of residents responding was 530, noting that individuals may not have answered some of the questions. Overall, residents seem to be satisfied with the city's communication, with 83.36% relying on our weekly eNews, Direct Connect.

As a reminder, this survey was not designed to be statistically representative. Rather, it was to capture a snapshot of general sentiment and perception from those who chose to respond. As such, the results are best understood as qualitative insights. The value of this survey lies in the patterns and themes that emerged from the responses. For example, staff noticed several questions regarding the police texting program that has stopped. Q1 What is your primary source of receiving information from the city?







Q11 How satisfied are you with city staff responding to your emails/calls?









Stompanato – great staff, very responsive, friendly and informed. Again, I'm always amazed at what gets done for the size of our staff. Great job!

Kenny – staff is always professional, friendly, and prompt with answers to questions from elected officials, residents and vendors.

Leganski – answers are always timely and detailed. No issues.

Belzcak – Getting memos for all of the other committees is a good practice as it keeps us well informed

Coren - Top notch!

Marchese – Being part of the daily staff operation provides me with an opportunity to see how the staff extends itself to our residents. Whether it is a phone call, office visit, or meeting with a resident or potential business owner, our staff always goes out of its way to communicate our message that we are here for our residents and businesses.

Top Priorities

Schauer – I believe we should identify as a city – all areas that need development or re-development; we need to identify and buy 2-3 acres of land for a future muni building; I think that since we are now 56 years old, we should identify any property, location, building, that needs to be fixed, improved or redevelopment. Example – TGIF building. I would reach out to Argonne and start a discussion with them about buying 3-4 acres of land that they are not using. They may give it away, may want money or we trade with for salt during winter (sounds like a stretch). However, anything to get for a future municipal services building is worth it. The fact is whether it is 10years or 20 years from now, we will need a new muni building (we need it now but not a necessity). I believe the cost of the land will be a major block on getting a new building. Once we get land, getting a building will be easier.

Stompanato -1) attracting new business and keep current businesses through extra support 2) ensuring our budgeting continues to take pensions into long-term planning – have we evaluated any potential large scale capital improvement projects due to age of city's infrastructure? 3) make sure we are putting enough effort into securing grant money for anything offered

Kenny -1) police pension will always be on this list 2) some administrative staff is approaching retirement age and will need to be replaced in some fashion 3) encouraging small business to grow in Darien to attract bigger business, and families to thrive in our community

Leganski – 1) strengthen relations with local businesses and strip malls 2) police pension liability – line by line budget review 3) work with real estate community to know why families are moving to and out of Darien

Gustafson – new public service building

Belczak – 1) work with District 61 on a permanent solution to the traffic/safety issues regarding school pick up at all 3 schools 2) reinstate a city sponsored coach light program to increase viability and safety 3) continue to improve relations with the Darien Park District

Sullivan – 1) fiscal management – police pension & avoid increase in real estate taxes; 2) continued partnership with park district; 3) TIF chestnut court – developer plan; 4) relationship with carriage green owners perhaps have 1 concert of multiple – (2026)

Coren - 1) fully staffed PD & Muni Services; 2) try to get residents to use direct connect more; 3) be proactive in attracting businesses to Darien

Ragona – 1) roadways; 2) sidewalks; 3) public works continue good job with snowplowing, water main repairs & storm sewer maintenance

Marchese – 1) Economic Development – bringing in additional revenue to negate increased pension costs; 2) continue to monitor our financial health in order to assure that we can maintain current services to our residents; 3) it is critical that we maintain our awareness of what goes on at the state level and how it can impact our city. We need to continue our involvement in groups such as DMMC in order to make sure that we are aware of issues that impact us.

Suggestions you have to improve city services

Schauer – I think we should increase street sweeping – what is the cost to buy a sweeper?

Stompanato – 1) better utilization of the marquee sign on Plainfield and Cass 2) Utilize google forms or equivalent to conduct quick hit surveys and publish results 3) focusing DBA on seeing what our Darien businesses are looking for from the city to better serve the residents. Review success of DBA since initial launch

Kenny – 1) look at more ways to help our city staff grow developmentally encouraging them to stay working in Darien 2) take another look at the possibility of returning auxiliary positions 3) increase opportunities for elected officials to see first-hand what happens with staff on a day to day basis

Leganski – 1) use media to let residents see projects being completed and equipment beings utilized 2) inform residents of all crime prevention equipment and techniques being utilized to protect our residents and keep our community safe. Bring back the police text system 3) continue to improve our cable station and Direct Connect.

Sullivan - 1)DBA fully integrate with Darien Business –provide clear directives and create multi-year plan & goals; 2) master succession plan for high level staff retirements 3) continue to improve communication & self promotion – increase frequency

Gustafson − 1) take over plowing for county 2) additional tree trimming 3) additional street sweeping

Belczak – 1) City services are outstanding however, we must be vigilant in seeking better ways to communicate with the residents. Far and away, the biggest complaint is "I didn't know that". This is more than a Darien problem it is a societal problem but we must continue to seek new and better ways to communicate with residents.

Coren – I think we do a pretty good job now. Sorry, no new ideas.

Marchese – 1) always look for ways to increase communication with residents, especially seniors. 2) build more bridges with community organizations and businesses. We need to work with businesses and assist them in understanding the need for their working together. We have many small businesses that can't take time to promote themselves; we need to show them the advantages of working together for their individual benefit. 3) we need to examine additional ways to provide our residents an opportunity to interact with one another. Providing entertainment/craft fairs etc. Work to achieve this objective.
