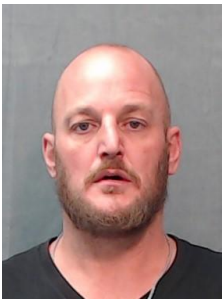
### In-Jurisdiction Warrant

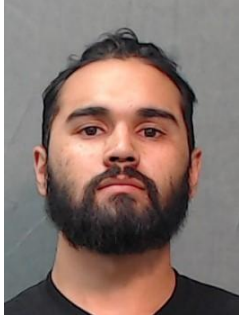


### Theft

The juvenile was then transported to the Kane County Juvenile Justice Center. The juvenile has a court appearance scheduled for June 22, 2026 at the DuPage County Judicial Center.
