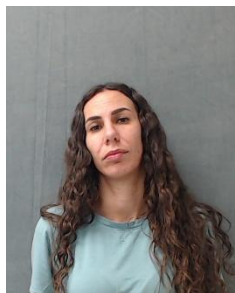

July 16

Driving While License Suspended
