March 5

Domestic Battery

At 11:24 a.m. officers were dispatched to the 3200 block of Beller Drive for a domestic battery. Due to visible injuries to the victim, the alleged offender, Anastasia Schiller, 39, of the 3200 block of Beller Drive, Darien, was transported to the Darien Police Department and charged with two counts of domestic battery. Schiller was then transported to the DuPage County Jail.



Warrant Service

At 11:15 p.m. an officer was conducting a traffic stop on Cass Avenue near I-55, exiting the squad car, when a vehicle was observed approaching I-55 who failed to slow down or move away from the squad car. The vehicle was close enough to cause the officer to step back and partially close the vehicle door to avoid being struck. A traffic stop was conducted on the offending vehicle. The driver, Demetria Williams, 27, of the 100 block of Winston Court, Bolingbrook, had an active failure to appear warrant out of the DuPage County Sheriff's office. Williams was issued citations for failure to yield to emergency vehicles, operate uninsured motor vehicle and no valid license. He was transported to the DuPage County Jail.

Burglary

Several front display cases were damaged and glass shattered to gain entry and several coin collections were taken. Total loss to Windy City Coin is unknown at this time.

Officers observed the front door glass shattered on the neighboring business, Zazzo's Pizza, 7360 Kingery Highway. Several cash register drawers were on the floor and behind the counter, along with several computer monitors knocked off the countertop. Loss from register \$211, total loss to Zazzo's is unknown at this time. .
